Responding to God

We're so glad that God has spoken to your heart and that you are willing to meet with Him.

To help you respond to the Holy Spirit's conviction, following are some steps of action. Please take whatever time is necessary to go through these so you can deal thoroughly with all that God has revealed to you.

Repentance

The process of dealing with sin involves two aspects:

- 1. Confessing or agreeing with God about two things.
 - Your sin (the fruit . . . wrong actions, words, attitudes, values, priorities, etc.)
 Be specific, and remember, "God gives grace to the humble."
 - Your self (the root)

Agree with God that the root of your sin is self – that when you sinned, you pushed Christ off the throne of your life and willfully chose to control it.

- 2. By faith, doing two things:
 - Thank God for His forgiveness based on the promise of His Word (Proverbs 28:13, 1 John 1:9).
 - Once again, yield control of your life to the Holy Spirit.
